
Terms and Conditions of Enrolment into TAFE PLUS courses



TAFE PLUS courses are delivered by TAFE NSW. TAFE NSW will make all reasonable efforts to ensure all scheduled classes run as advertised. However, TAFE NSW reserves the right to:

- run or withdraw any course
- hold a course at a college/campus or location other than that advertised
- alter the times or dates for the whole or any part of the course

If any of these course changes become necessary, you will be advised in advance where possible, of the changes and the alternative arrangements which will be made available for you to complete your course.

Enrolment in courses is contingent on the payment of the prescribed course fee and places are allocated on receipt of payment.

Minimum age to register in a course is 15. Please note that participants enrolling in any course where alcohol is involved must be 18 years of age or over.

Conditions and Refunds

Cancellations advised in writing more than seven days prior to the commencement of the program are eligible for a full refund. For cancellations advised within seven days of the program no refunds are made, however a substitute delegate may attend. Course fees cannot be refunded to participants who are unable to attend classes for reasons beyond our control. Courses are run subject to demand. If there are insufficient numbers, courses may be cancelled or deferred to another date. In this case, course fees can be either refunded or credited towards another course. Places in courses are allocated on receipt of payment.
